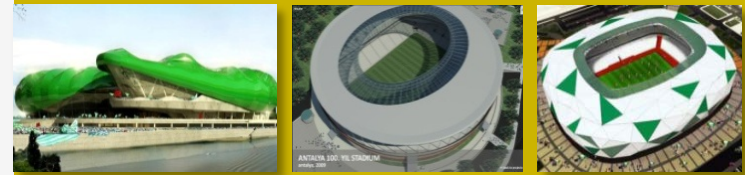

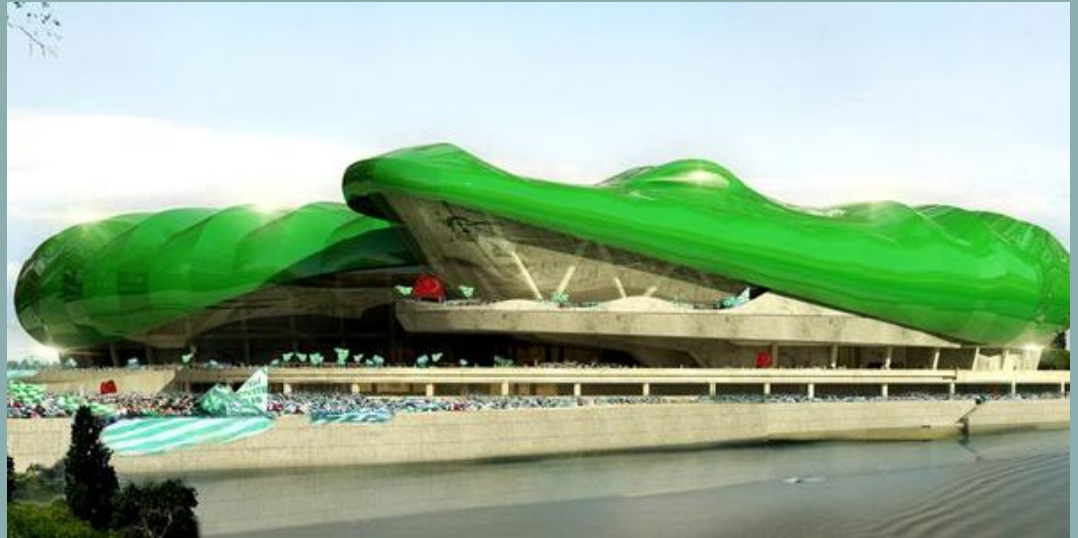

Timsah Arena, Bursa, North West Turkey

Capacity: 43,670 seats
Scheduled opening: 2013



- The iconic structure of the Timsah (Turkish for crocodile) Arena is inspired by its name. The crocodile wrapped structure comes in full form with high-powered illumination lighting up the eyeholes of the 'reptile'.
- Estimated cost : €70 million
- Commissioned by Turkish Football club Bursaspor, and publicly financed by the city of Bursa.
- Designed by Bursa-based practice Sozuner Architects

New Antalya Stadium, Antalya South West Turkey

Capacity: 41703 seats
Scheduled opening: 2014



- Resembling a Mediterranean sea shell, this stadium will be a landmark of the Riviera coastline.
- Estimated cost: € 158.3 million
- *“Attracting some 20 million tourists every year as well as 1,500 sports teams for training venues with its high-quality sports fields, favorable climate, premium facilities and natural beauty, Antalya deserves a stadium at a world standard” - Çetin Osman Budak, head of Antalya Chamber of Industry and Commerce*

Konya Büyükşehir Stadı, Konya Central Turkey

Capacity: 42,000 seats
Scheduled opening: 2014



- Most distinctive elements of the stadium are its exterior and roof made up of triangular shapes, in the club colors of Konyaspor, Green and White.
- The stadium is aimed at hosting future European Championships and complies with all UEFA requirements.

New Eskişehir Stadium, Eskişehir North West Turkey

Capacity: 33,000 seats
Scheduled opening: 2014



- Estimated cost: €80 Million
- The inner walls will be constructed partially with serigraphic glass to provide maximum transparency from the inside and to emphasize its open character at night.
- The stadium will replace the current home ground of Turkish Football Club, Eskişehirspor

New Izmir Stadium, Izmir South West Turkey

Capacity: 41,540 seats
Scheduled opening: 2014



- Estimated cost: €125.1 Million
- Also known as “Ege’nin Gözbebeği” (the apple of the Aegean eye), the stadium is inspired by historic influences of Hellenic and Roman architecture.
- Situated on a hill north of Izmir Bay, the iconic structure stands alone resembling a lighthouse on the Aegean coastline.

Mersin Olimpiyat Stadi, Mersin South Turkey

Capacity: ~ 25,000 seats
Scheduled opening: 2014



- Financing from governmental agency TOKI
- Stadium contractor responsible for erecting the structure: Uzunlar, Turkish construction giant
- Stadium should be temporarily operational during June-July 2013 for the Mediterranean Games
- The seating arrangement is such that 5,000 will be seated in premium zones of the business sections (over 3,700) and skyboxes (over 900).
